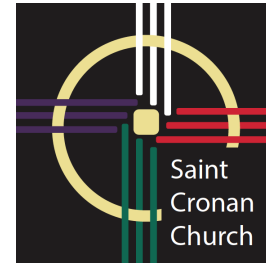

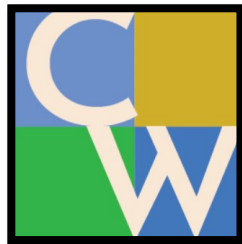
Monday November 18th at 6pm: Round Table discussion on Pope Francis's teachings on the economy (see our website stlcatholicworker.org for readings)
