#### A reading from the Gospel of Matthew

Jesus said to his disciples: "When the Messiah comes in glory, together with all the angels, the Messiah will sit on a glorious throne.

All the nations will be gathered before the throne, and the Holy One will separate them one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and will place the sheep on one side, and the goats on the other.

Then the Chosen One will say to some, 'Come, O blessed ones of God, inherit the realm prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you clothed me, I was sick and you visited me, I was in prison and you came to me.'

Then they will answer and say, 'When did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or ill or in prison, and did not minister to your needs?'

Then the Holy One will answer them, 'Amen, I say to you, what you did not do for one of these least ones, you did not do for me.'

And they will go off to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life."
