A Hill to Climb

We are again entering into the Archdiocesan Annual Catholic Appeal (ACA) season. This year we have "a hill to climb"! When I first received the communication from the ACA office they pegged our goal at \$32,900. I fell off my chair since last year's goal was \$16,568! That was almost a 50% increase. I appealed that recommendation and they lowered our goal to \$24,500. But even that is a stretch. Last year we contributed \$20,492 to the ACA. Since I have been here we have never missed our goal. If we are to continue that streak then there will need to be a little increase in each of our gifts. I asked that each of you consider upping your donation. Inflation has gripped all of us but not like it has hit those on the margins of our society. I believe many of us can afford to forego just a little in order that the needy are not slighted.

The theme this year is: For the Life of the World. St. Cronan is the liveliest Parish/"Church" I have ever been honored to serve. I never take the gifts of joy, unity, service outreach etc. for granted. I hope you do not either. We are blessed with so many talented, insightful, giving, professional, self-actualized, energetic,

generous folks. And we have so many exciting young adults! So many in our community need a "lifeline" and the ACA can facilitate that giving of life. I was associated with Catholic Charities for over 14 years and I had the opportunity to see "life transfusions" because of the dedicated staffs and programs that Catholic Charities offers. 
