Thank you, thank you for being "fire starters". I am so grateful for the faith and energy of the people of St. Cronan. Know that you are in my prayers and that I will continue to serve you.


and energy were a joy and a big help for us. The pancake breakfast was a wonderful community event and thank you all for making it happen!


